## **Dear Parents**

I have a couple of things I need to remind everyone about.

- Firstly can everyone entering the school please sign in. We have to answer to health & safety regulations and are often asked to provide evidence of people signing in. Can I also remind you that if the fire alarm was to sound then everyone should evacuate the building and line up on the field where we can do a roll call with the registers & signing in book. (Please note that if your child is being taught in the hall then we are responsible for them & we will evacuate them from the building.)
- There have been lots of lost property lately and very few items are named. Please label all dance clothes and shoes, so we can get them back to you.
- Can I also remind you that the children's hair needs to be tied up for dancing and that jewellery should not be worn. We still have lots of pupils coming into class with earrings in and asking for tape. I'm sure a lot of them have had their ears pierced for longer than 6 weeks and we will be asking them to be removed.
- Now that the evenings are drawing in, Can I ask the parents of Juniors 3&4 to come to the door & collect your children, as we cant see who is in the car, plus the children are running out across the playground in the dark where cars are driving.
- We are now well into preparations for the show, and I would like to ask if anyone would like to help with cutting costumes out or sewing them up, please see me as every little bit of help makes it easier for us. (please don't be afraid of having ago as I will show you how to do everything!!!)
- If anyone would like to be a chaperone and help back stage at the show (Not one your child is in) and have a CRB certificate please see me as soon as possible.
- Can I also remind all parents that our dancing school policy of no pants to be worn under costumes. If anyone has a problem with this then you should see me asap. As to not upset the child/children on the day of the show.

JUNIORS 1 & 2.......White satin ballet shoes, ( to be handed in to Joyce by Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> January to be dyed turquoise.) Green Hawaiian Hula Skirt & Hawaiian flower garlands for the wrists, around the neck and hair available from Joyce for £4. Childs own bikini any colour. Tan shimmer stirrup tights and tan shimmer tights.

JUNIORS 3 & 4......White satin ballet shoes. (to be handed into Joyce by Saturday January 11<sup>th</sup> to be dyed green). Straw coloured Hawaiian skirt & Hawaiian flower garlands for around the neck wrists and on the head. available form Joyce for £6. Tan shimmer stirrup tights and tan shimmer tights.

INTERMEDIATES......black ballet or point shoes both with ribbons on (like point shoes). Black lycra hot pants. Own 80s style fame costume. Plain Black over the knee socks.

SENIORS...... Black New Yorker/Character shoes. Plain black dance sneakers. Own black sleeveless leotard for the acro dance.

ADVANCED.....pink ballet practise shoes.

As soon as I have any more details regarding any of the above I will let you know.

The full costume lists will go out with the costumes, but if you are unsure of any of the above please come and see me.
